Honorary Member-For-Life

Qualification for Honorary Member: Article V, Membership, Qualification, Application, Acceptance, Section 6, Qualifications of Honorary Members, of the Bylaws states: “Honorary members shall be those persons engaged in the real estate profession and recognized by the Board of Directors as persons who have performed notable service for the real estate profession, for the Association or for the public. Honorary membership may be conferred by the Board of Directors upon a nominee who has given exemplary service to uphold the reputation of the Association and who has also completed at least two of following(Cannot be 2 & 4):

1. Past President of the Association, merged Association/Board, or;
2. Fifteen years of membership in the Association, merged Association/Board, or a Charter Member;
3. 65 years of age;
4. Any member with 25 years of membership in an Association/Board is eligible, subject to assessment of their contribution to the Association/Board over that term of membership.

The Board of Directors shall confer no more than two (2) Honorary memberships in any one year.”

Procedure: The following point system will be used to assist in the selection process:
(The point system is based on each year)

- 5 points: Board/Association President
- 4 points: Board/Association Officer (other than President)
- 3 points: Board/Association Director (other than Officer)
- 3 points: REALTOR®-Associate Director
- 4 points: REALTOR®-Of-The-Year and/or REALTOR®-Associate-Of-The-Year
- 2 points: Chairman of a Committee, Chair of Task Force and/or special committee
- 1 point: Member of Committee, Task Force or special committee
- *2 points: For age 65 or over (*maximum points allowed)
- 1 point: 15 to 20 years of Board/Association membership
- 2 points: 20 to 24 years of Board/Association membership
- *3 points: 25 years and over of Board/Association membership (*maximum points allowed)
- 2 points: For each professional real estate designation
- 1 to 3 points: At the discretion of the Membership/Education Committee for local government/community activities

Please note: A minimum of 60 points is necessary to be eligible to qualify for consideration for Honorary Member for Life.
